- ▣ The Undergraduate Club would like to propose that it establish this Facebook group with the Graduate Club. GAAB members and other alumni can then join the group.

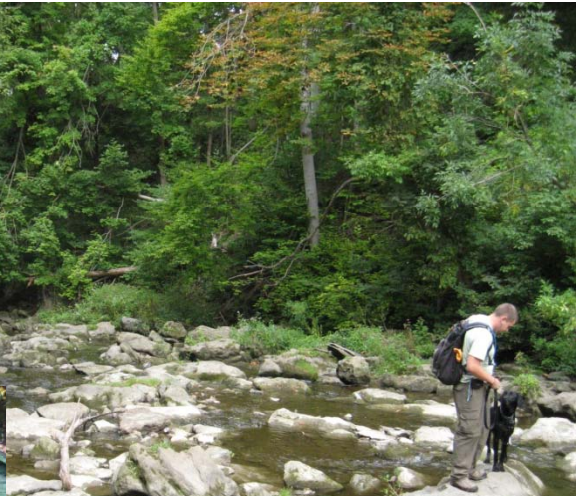
Workshops
